The Governing Body of the City of Emporia, Kansas, met in Adjourned Session, Wednesday, October 14, 2020, in the City Commission Meeting Room with Mayor Giefer present and Commissioners Brinkman, Geitz, Gilligan and Smith present. Also present were City Manager McAnarney, Assistant City Manager Massey, City Clerk Sull and City Attorney Montgomery.

**CITY COMMISSION
(Mitigation Plan)
(Resolution Number 3638)**

Joe Foster, Zoning Enforcement Officer, was recognized and addressed the Governing Body. He stated the Lyon County Office of Emergency Management is the designated Emergency Management agency for Lyon county, which includes the City of Emporia. As the designated agency, they are required to prepare and update the hazard mitigation plan and submit it to the State of Kansas. He stated the Regional Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is completed every five years. The purpose of adopting Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is for the City to be entitled to mitigation funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in the event of a large emergency due to severe weather, flooding and wildfires. He stated this plan identified potential project and strategies of mitigation to identified threats and hazards. He stated staff is recommending the adoption of the Mitigation Plan which entitles the City to mitigation funding in the future.

Commissioner Brinkman made a motion to approve Resolution Number 3638, a resolution adopting the Kansas Homeland (Region I) Hazard Mitigation Plan. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion. The vote follows: Commissioner Brinkman, aye; Commissioner Smith, aye; Commissioner Geitz, aye; Commissioner Gilligan, aye; and Mayor Giefer, aye.
